Coronavirus: best hygiene practices in the Church of England:

- parishioners with coughs and sneezes are advised to refrain from handshaking during The Peace and to receive Communion in one kind only (bread, NOT wine);
- 2. hand-sanitisers are available for parishioners to use;
- 3. priests presiding at the Eucharist, communion administrators and servers should wash their hands, preferably with an alcohol-based hand-sanitiser;
- 4. intinction (dipping bread in wine) is not recommended (even by celebrants or communion-administrators) as this represents an infection transmission route.
- 5. there is no Government advice that suggests the Common Cup should be suspended.
