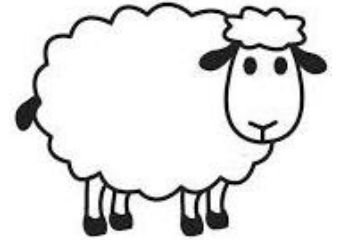


# Find the lost sheep!

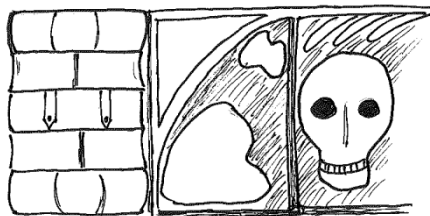
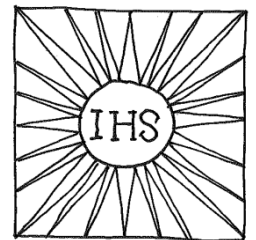


## 1. Font

A bowl for water to baptise babies in. This makes them part of the church family. Font is a Latin word meaning fountain, well or spring.

## 2. Pulpit

The priest stands here so people can see and hear him or her. Pulpit is also a Latin word. IHS is a symbol meaning 'Jesus'.



## 3. George Abbot's Tomb

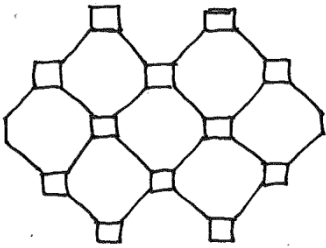
He was Archbishop of Canterbury and loved books. Can you see the piles of books?

The bones tell us that everyone will die one day.

## 4. Altar

Important parts of the service happen here. The lamb is another symbol of Jesus.





## 5. Queen's Regimental Chapel

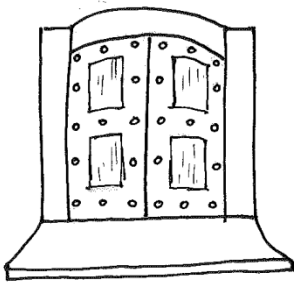
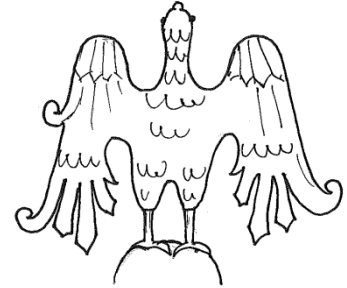
The chapel for the local regiment, where soldiers who have died are remembered.

Can you spot more lambs here? The lamb is the badge of the Regiment.

## 6. Lectern

This holds the Bible so people can read aloud from it.

Lectern is another Latin word. The eagle is a symbol of St. John who wrote part of the Bible.



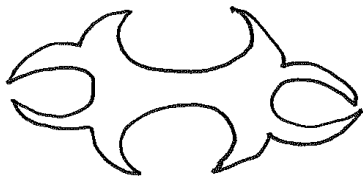
## 7. War Memorial

For the men of the Queen's Regiment who died in the First and Second World Wars.



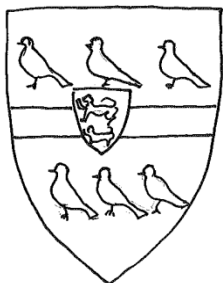
## 8. First World War Memorial

For the men of Holy Trinity and St Mary's churches who died in the First World War.



## 9. St Luke's Chapel

Somewhere quiet where people can pray on their own.



## 10. Arthur Onslow

He was an important local Member of Parliament who helped to get the new church built after the old one fell down in 1740.

*Jesus told another story about a woman who had 10 silver coins. When she lost one, she searched everywhere until she found it, then had a party for her friends to celebrate. This is another way of saying that God loves us all and won't let us be lost or forgotten.*
