The Rector mentioned Zeppelins in the London area – which had struck Guildford on October 13th (probably by mistake) – and told the parish not to worry, but to trust in God. ‘Let us keep our heads, control our feelings, and remember that we are British’.

An Invalid’s Guild of Intercession was suggested, for those who could not get to church.

A long prayer was printed for use in wartime, and it was noted that the darkened streets were deterring people from going to evening meetings.

No war dead were listed.
