## Babies & Toddlers (0-3 yrs)

Every Sunday during the 10.00 Eucharist at Holy Trinity small children are welcome to play with toys in St Luke's Chapel and the Children's Corner accompanied by their parents. Toy bags are also distributed to little ones on arrival to enjoy during the service.



## Junior Church (3-7 yrs)

We meet every Sunday in term time to have fun whilst talking and thinking about God during the 10.00 Eucharist at Holy Trinity. Starting in church, we go to the Trinity Centre during the first hymn where we tell a story in the form of 'Godly Play', do a craft activity, have a drink and a biscuit and say prayers before joining the main service for a blessing towards the end of Communion.



## Trinity Breakfast Club (8+ yrs)

Trinity Breakfast Club is a very informal, lively group which meets in the Trinity Centre during the 10.00 Eucharist. Alongside teaching from the Roots programme designed for this age group, there is a very successful series of visitors from members of the HTSM congregations who come to talk about their service in the community or something else which has enriched their lives. We usually rejoin the service for Communion when the children can receive a blessing if they have not celebrated their **First Communion**.



## Participating in worship

Twice a term the children and adults all stay together for the Eucharist at 10.00 or for a special seasonal service at Harvest, Christmas and on Mothering Sunday. On these occasions, children are invited to take on a special role: handing out hymn books, taking the collection, carrying candles, reading, leading the prayers and more. Some children may already be choristers or servers; others may prefer to sit with their parents and friends in the congregation.



## Social events

Various social activities for children and parents happen throughout the year. Highlights include the Christmas party after the Nativity service, Parish Bingo and a summer party at the Rectory.
